	<p>Quorum The quorum was established with a total of 99 registered delegates at 10.00am. Meeting was called to order at 10.30am.</p>
1	<p>Opening Address by President President welcomed and thanked all members present who had taken the time and effort to travel from their respective states to attend the 14th Malaysian Nash Hash (MNH) and 15th Biennial General Meeting (BGM) today.</p> <p>Before proceeding with the meeting, the President offered his condolence to Dato’ Nadaraja on his recent loss and one (1) minute silence was observed in remembrance of our departed hashers and family members.</p> <p>A big hand to all delegates who stayed back after attending the MNH and delegates who had especially travelled from near and far to attend this meeting today. The MHF congratulates the Organising Committee headed by, Dato’ Nadaraja “Rojak” Grand Master of Mont’ Kiara H4, OC, Lady Goat, Assistant OC, Lan Kaw Seng who have taken the challenge and put in immense time and effort to organise a successful MNH in these trying times. This is also made possible due to the hard work, generous contributions and support from MKH4 members, sponsors and hashers alike. Syabas and Terima Kasih.</p> <p>The amendments to the MHC Constitution, which was approved at the 14th BGM held on 10th July 2022 in Johore Baru, was ratified at an EGM held on 27th August 2023. The approved amendments were submitted to the Registrar of Societies by the President and approval was received on 12th November 2023. We are now known as the Malaysian Hash Federation (MHF) and guided by the Sports Development Act 1987. We are following up with the Commissioner of Sports for their approval and recognition of Hash as a Recreational Sport and liaising with the Olympic Council of Malaysia for admission as an Associate Member.</p> <p>We take this opportunity to welcome and acknowledge our new affiliates, SICO H3 from Selangor, Valdor H3, Sg Bakap and Northern Lions H3 from Penang and Kelab Harimau Harriers H3 and Daring H3 from Kedah.</p> <p>Some chapters had difficulty to register the Acronym “Hash” or “Harriers” at their state level ROS office as the ROS required all wordings to be in Bahasa Malaysia. The issues were resolved with timely assistance of our the Council members and our Advisor. We now have a total 133 affiliates.</p> <p>MHF celebrated our 25th Anniversary Gala Dinner and Dance in Langkawi on 17th and 18th February 2023. We thank all our affiliates and Committee Members for their support in making it a memorable event of hashing, fellowship and camaraderie.</p> <p>In February 2023, MHC collaborated with the Young Talent Track and Field (YTTF), a non profit organisation made up of ex-national athletes to provide “free” training on a weekly basis to kids aged from 6 years to 16 years. A noble effort to develop young talent and expose them to trail running and survival skills in the jungles which would reinforce their self-confidence and social skills.</p> <p>A fund raising Run for Young Talent 2023 was held on 7th May 2023 at the PJ Club. The hash trail was jointly led by President with PJ club hashers and supported by hashers from KL, Selangor and Perak Chapters. A Gala Dinner was</p>

	<p>held at Hee Lai Ton Restaurant, PJ, on 23rd June 2023. We thank all our Hashers for their support and our 12 Hashers who sponsored the training program for one year for 12 kids. With this collaboration, the MHF received RM5,147.50 from YTF.</p> <p>We also received a surprise donation of RM500 from Cameraman, the OC of Pan Songkran Run and RM1,100 from “Toddy King”, GM of Harapan Baru H3. I thank them for their kind gesture to start the fund raising ball rolling.</p> <p>I thank my council members who have sacrificed their time, effort and money to attend the various meetings and celebration runs. Council members continuously support and contribute towards sponsorship of the state and chapter celebration events. Our travel and accommodation expenses are from our own pockets as the MHF does not have a regular source of income and funds. Appreciation goes out to Parit Buntar H3, WFR H3, Kota Setar H3 and Kinta Rainforest H4, for giving the Council members either waiver of the registration fee or waiver of registration fee and lodging provided during their recent Celebration Runs.</p> <p>I am pleased to announce that the 15th Malaysian Nash Hash 2026 (MNH) will be jointly organised by four (4) chapters from Malacca. The team headed by Gary Tan and Au Kiat informed that all delegates present today will be entitled for the early bird rate. The details of the event will be announced by the team shortly.</p> <p>I must stress that it is pertinent for all hashers to maintain a positive image and a healthy lifestyle. We must also take care and be considerate for our environment and continue to assist the less fortunate by contributing our time, effort and resources in making their lives more comfortable. I salute all hashers who have embarked in this noble effort. The MHF recognised their effort and awarded tokens of appreciation to these outstanding hashers at our 25th Anniversary Dinner and Dance. I congratulate the KL Rep. and GM of MKH4 Dato’ Nadaraja for further recognising their efforts at last night’s Main Dinner where tokens of appreciation were given out to “Cowboy” & “Sodam” from PJ Anemales and “Goodyear” from Penang H3.</p> <p>Thank you and I wish you good health and happiness always. Drive safe and see you at the next celebration run. On On.</p>
<p>2. 2.1</p>	<p><u>Confirmation of Minutes of Meeting</u> Minutes of the 14th BGM held on 18th July 2022 at Forest City Marina Hotel, Forest City, Johore</p> <p>Hon. Sec informed members that the minutes of the meeting have been circulated to all Affiliates and requested for a proposer and seconder to confirm and adopt the minutes.</p> <p>The proxy for Penang Rainforest H4, Ramamoorthy R “Kutta” informed that he received the Notice of Meeting only two (2) days ago. This is against the Constitution and thus this meeting is invalid.</p> <p>Hon Sec. informed that the notice of meeting had been posted and circulated to members on 9th May, 2024 on the MHF website and at all the MHF Affiliates State Whatsapp Groups. He inquired from the floor whether any member present did not receive the Notice of BGM and attachments. Members present unanimously agreed that the Notice of Meeting was timely circulated.</p> <p>The minutes of the 14th BGM was proposed to be adopted by Johan Van Geysel, “Ex Pat” of Fukarawee SF and seconded by Venugopal “Kattaboman”, SP Fullmoon H3.</p> <p>2.2 <u>Minutes of 1st EGM held on 27th August 2023 at Indian Association, Nibong Tebal</u></p> <p>Hon. Sec informed that amendments to the MHC Constitution was unanimously approved by members at the 14th BGM on 18th July 2022. Submission of the amendments to ROS was out of time and pursuant to the requirement by the ROS, an EGM was called to ratify the amendments. The members present at the EGM unanimously approved the proposed ratification. The approved amendments was submitted to ROS by the President and ROS approval was received on 12th November 2023.</p> <p>The minutes of the 1st EGM was proposed to be adopted by Munusamy “Tok Guru” from Valdor H3 and seconded by Ballan Sathu Nair “Toddy King” from Harapan Baru H4.</p>
<p>3.</p>	<p><u>Matters Arising</u> There were no Matters arising.</p>
<p>4.</p>	<p><u>Secretary’s Report</u> Hon. Sec briefed the members on the list of Committee members elected at the 14th BGM held on 10th July 2022. Total Affiliates Membership is currently 233 i.e. existing 227 plus 6 new affiliates joined during the term. One (1)</p>

affiliate KL H3 (Mother Hash) has left the MHF.

A total 8 Council meetings were held during this term. The last meeting was held on 7th June 2023.

The MHC 25th Anniversary Gala Dinner and Dance was held in Langkawi. The Pub Crawl held on 17th February 2023 was attended by 171 Hashers whereas the Dinner held on 18th February 2023 was attended by 255 hashers.

MHC is proud to inform of its collaboration with the Selangor Young Talent Track and Field (YTTF) and Kelab PJ. They held their first outdoor activity run to raise awareness amongst the young on 7th May 2023. A fund raising dinner was held on 22nd July 2023 and 12 hash members sponsored 12 young children for their 12 months training program.

Our Council members together with the State Reps assisted some new chapters in Penang and Kedah to include the word “Hash” or “Harriers” in their formation for registration with ROS.

Our application for an Internet Banking facility was approved by Maybank. on 29th April 2024. We are now able to do online banking instead of issuing cheques. Task done by President, Hon. Sec and Treasurer.

The Committee played an important role in assisting Chapters as advisory for celebration or state runs and assisting to resolve disputes between members and their clubs.

We are now known as the Malaysian Hash Federation (MHF) and guided by the Sports Development Act 1987. The amendments to the MHC Constitution, which was approved at the 14th BGM held on 10th July 2022 in Johore Baru, was ratified at an EGM held on 27th August 2023. President was instrumental in the follow up and submission of the approved amendments to ROS.

Our website is going through transformation from MHC to MHF as we have changed our logo and registered a domain as malaysiahashfederation.com to replace malaysianhashcouncil.com when it expires later in the year. By typing either name, users will be directed to the same website. We have included the Google calendar in our website to enable visitors /members to view chapter celebration runs which have been informed by member chapters to the MHF. We hope to raise funds to revamp the current website as it is more than 6 years old and has limited functionality. The budget proposed is RM6,000.00.

As members are aware, our operating funds are limited and all travel and accommodation expenses are borne solely by the council members when attending MHF functions. We are grateful to our President for sponsoring some official uniforms for the Council members.

5. **Treasurer’s Report**

5.1 **Income & Expenditure and Balance Sheet**

5.2	<p>H4. The accounts were unanimously passed and adopted.</p> <p>25th Anniversary Dinner & Dance Hon. Sec briefed on the Income & Expenditure of the 25th Anniversary Dinner & Dance Accounts. Ramamoorthy R “Kutta” Penang Rainforest H4 inquired on the expenditure of RM9,382.00 from Asia Sports Centre. The Treasurer informed that the payment was for T-shirts and Freebies for the MHC Gala Dinner and Dance.</p> <p>The member further inquired on the expenditure of RM87,324.85 which exceeds the income of RM83,495.00 which shows a loss of RM3,829.85.</p> <p>President explained that the bulk of the expenses is due to the 25th Anniversary Dinner and Dance. The current total balance in the Income & Expenditure of the Federation is in credit. The Dinner & Dance was organised for the Hashers and the Federation made a decision not to make a profit from members. There was a shortfall of RM3,900.00, due from some members and sponsors for the magazine advertisements who committed but did not pay/attend. This shortfall was covered from the main account.</p> <p>The delay in finalising the accounts was due to follow up on collections some of which are still outstanding. We are following-up with the chapters concerned. A detailed breakdown of the Dinner and Dance accounts had been earlier circulated to members for their information. For future events, payments must be collected upfront to avoid such issues.</p> <p>Hardip Singh “Ichi Bhai” 420 H3 proposed to adopt the 25th Anniversary Dinner & Dance Accounts. Secunder Anoop Singh “Fraud Tiger” Kelab Aman H4. The accounts were unanimously passed and adopted.</p>
6.	<p><u>Nash Hash & State Charters</u> No changes.</p>
7.	<p><u>Any Other Matters</u> President informed members that two (2) resolutions are received by the Federation. Advisor Darshan Singh “Dash” will brief on the resolutions. Advisor briefed as follows:</p> <p>7.1 Resolution 1 - per Clause 13.1 (c) Candidate Election Form (where required) and attendance at the BGM (where required) have been sent to the Hon. Secretary 14 (fourteen) days prior to the BGM. <u>Amendment</u> It is proposed that a member who wishes to be a candidate for election to the Malaysian Hash Federation Committee, shall complete the Nomination Form which is to reach the Hon. Secretary not less than 21 days prior to the BGM. The President together with the Hon. Secretary shall be responsible to declare the candidacy valid (or otherwise) and inform the candidate accordingly as soon as possible. The list of approved candidates for all positions shall be circulated to all affiliated chapters at least 14 (fourteen) days prior to the BGM. Nominees may withdraw their candidacy in writing at anytime before the BGM and this shall be made known to the other nominees and candidates immediately.</p> <p>The 14 (fourteen) days notice for the BGM Attendance Form to reach the Hon. Secretary 14 (days) prior to the BGM remains unchanged. Proposer: MHF Committee</p> <p>Johan “Ex Pat” Fukarwee SF proposed to adopt the resolution. The resolution was adopted and unanimously approved by all members present. Resolution 1 is carried.</p> <p>7.2 Resolution 2 - This BGM held on 9th June 2024 resolves that in view of the lack of funding available to the Malaysian Hash Federation, every affiliated Chapter shall endeavour to contribute a minimum of RM500.00 from the surplus of their Anniversary Celebrations. Proposer: Ramamoorthy a/l Ratnam Penang Rainforest H4. Secunder: Sugumaran Maniam Harapan Baru H4.</p> <p>John Sundaresan “Vampire” Harimau Kelana Jaya H3 inquired whether the resolution affected the constitution and contribution is compulsory or voluntary?</p>

	<p>Advisor informed that it does not affect the constitution and the contributions are voluntary.</p> <p>Ramu Ramasamy “Rubber” Garuda H3 proposed a payment of RM100 from affiliates on a yearly basis. Advisor informed it is a good idea.</p> <p>Venugopal “Kattaboman” SP Fullmoon H4 informed some chapters may not want to contribute. Advisor informed it is not compulsory.</p> <p>The motion was unanimously approved by the members present.</p>																																																													
8.	<p>Malaysian Nash Hash 2026</p> <p>President informed that the invitation for the bid to host the 15th Malaysia Nash 2026 was sent to all affiliates on 11th April 2024. On 6th May 2024, Malacca H3 submitted that their proposed Bid of the 15th MNH be jointly hosted by Malacca H3, Orang Utan H3, Kota Melaka H3 and Malacca Full Moon H3 from 19th to 21st June 2026. The recovery run and 16th BGM will be held on 21st June 2023. The bid details were comprehensive and complied with the Hash Charter. There being no other Bids, the Committee unanimously awarded the Bid to Malacca H3</p> <p>Au Kait, was invited to address the members on the details of the Bid. The early bird price is RM240 which incorporates the Red Dress Charity Run (RM40.00) of which 50% i.e. RM20.00 will go to a known charity. All delegates present today will be entitled for the early bird price for two (2) registrations each. He further informed that the trail will follow the original trail of the Springgit H3 . They were one of the earliest founders of the Hash. The Handover of the MNH flag from Dato “Rojak”, GM of Mount Kiara H4 as the organiser of the 14th MNH to Au Kait, OC of the 15th MNH was witnessed by the President and members present.</p>

MALAYSIAN HASH FEDERATION NASH HASH CHARTER

1. The Malaysian Nash Hash (MNH) shall as far as possible coincide with the Biennial General Meeting (B.G.M) of the Malaysian Hash Federation (MHF) which is to be held biennially not later than 30th June in that particular year.
2. *The MNH can be organised by a single chapter or two (2) or more chapters on a rotational basis in line with Clause (7) herein.*
3. The host/s must be affiliates of the MHF and have the following criteria:
 - Actively hashing for the last 5 years.
 - Run on a weekly/fortnightly or monthly basis
 - Have successfully organised at least 1 (one) celebration run in the last 5 years.
 - Have participated in previous Nash Hash events.
4. The following details must be furnished to the MHF upon submission of the Bid:
 - Background/experience of the hashers/hash chapter/s who are bidding to be the Host.
 - Proposed details of the event eg. date, venue, registration fees, programme, goodies, accomodation, transport arrangements, etc. Should the run-sites be away from the venue, regular shuttle services are to be provided between the run-site, main venue and designated hotels.
 - Proposed budget for the event.
 - Letter of Undertaking (please refer to **Attachment 1**).
5. Registration fee up to a maximum fee of RM450.00:
 - a) Early Bird of not more than RM200.00. The limit of the number of pax for the early bird registrants is at the discretion of the host.
 - b) After the cut-off date of the early bird registration, the host has the discretion to impose a progressive charge of up to a maximum of RM450.00 over the remaining period with a cut-off of 'No Goodies' - 3 (three) months before the event.
 - c) Ball Breaker Run (**optional**) additional RM120.00 - RM150.00 for hashers; RM200.00 for non-hashers:
 - Open (non-hashers) & Closed (restricted to hashers of affiliated chapters);
 - Ladies & Men (i) below 40 and (ii) above 40 (veteran);
 - Prizes and medallions given to 1st 5 winners in each category with finisher's t.shirts.
 - d) The officers of the MHF shall be entitled to pay 50% of the registration fees.
6. The registration fee is to include the following:
 - 1st Day Charity Run/Walk
Welcome Dinner & Duty Paid Beverages
 - 2nd Day Runs – short/old farts, medium, long & ball breaker (optional), Event Dinner & Beverages
 - 3rd Day Recovery Run/Walk cum Lunch and Biennial Delegates Meeting (B.D.M.)

7. The MHF shall shortlist the bid/s which must comply with the terms of the Charter to reach the Council latest within three (3) months prior the B.G.M, failing which, the Federation has the discretion to call for more bids. Should there be more than one (bid), the “shortlisted bids” will be put forward for the vote of Delegates at the B.D.M. The bidder with a simple majority shall be the Host. Should there be no bid, the Federation has the discretion to award the bid to a “qualified” affiliate or undertake to organise/corrobrate with a ‘qualified’ affiliate to host the event. The summary of Malaysian Nash Hash hosts is as per **Attachment 2**.
8. An administration fee of RM150.00 and deposit of RM6K (i.e. RM6.00 per participant for 1,000 participants) is paid to the MHF prior to the bid, If the bid is unsuccessful, the deposit will be refunded.
9. The balance of RM6.00 from the entry fee of each registered participant >1,000 participants is remitted to the MHF 1 month prior to the start of the Nash Hash. The payment of late registration fees shall be remitted to the MHF latest within 2 weeks after the event.
10. The Host shall disseminate on pertinent details of the Nash Hash via social media and have a MNH souvenir magazine. The MHF shall be allotted a minimum of 6 pages in the magazine for the President’s Address, History of MHF/MNH, etc. The MHF shall provide assistance wherever possible via the MHF website, state whatsapp chat group, social media, etc. to promote a successful event.
11. All promotional items eg. t.shirts, backdrop, banners, buntings, magazines etc, are to bear the MHF logo.
12. Information of other related activities i.e. Charity Run, Pre/Post-Amble Runs, etc. must be advertised early in order for hashers to make the necessary preparations.
13. The Host is to make all the necessary preparations with the MHF Chairman/Hon.Secretary to host the B.G.M of the Malaysian Hash Federation!. The Federation is to be briefed on the preparations of the MNH with a site visit to the venue 1-3 months prior to the event. A principal officer of the MHF shall be assigned to the Organising Committee for guidance and advice and shall be the liason with the host.
14. The audited accounts for the MNH is signed-off by an external auditor and presented to members of the organising chapter (s) and MHF within 3 months upon completion of the event.
15. The Malaysian Nash Hash is governed under Section 6.3, Functions of the Council, MHF Constitution.

MALAYSIAN HASH FEDERATION(MHF) STATE LEVEL HASH CHARTER

1. The state level run is to be organised annually or biennially on a rotational basis among affiliated chapters in each state to be known as eg. "10th MHF Kedah/Perlis State Run".
2. State representatives must engage with the affiliates to select the Host by a majority decision among the bidders with sufficient notice of at least 1 (one) month being given to the prospective bidders:
 - On a rotational basis.
 - The host may be a single chapter or a combination of with two or more chapters. States with many chapters are strongly advised to form joint organising committees and hold the event on an annual basis so that future bidders can get their turn sooner than later.
 - The state rep shall be an ex-officio member of the Organising Committee who will liaise with the MHF.
 - A principal officer of the MHF shall be assigned to the Organising Committee for guidance and advice.
3. The Organising Chapter/s (O.C's) must be affiliated to the Malaysian Hash Federation and have the following criteria.
 - The OC/OC's were active for the last 3 years;
 - The chapter/s must be running on a weekly/fortnightly or monthly basis;
 - The chapter/s has not less than 20 members;
 - have had the experience of organising a successful celebration run in the last 5 years.
4. The philosophy of the one (1) day event is:
 - "Back to Basics" to keep cost at a minimal level;
 - Foster fellowship and support among state chapters with a contribution of at least RM150.00 carton of beverages each (or equivalent) towards the event;
 - Maximum Registration charge of RM120.00 - RM150.00;
 - Registration without goodies shall not exceed two-thirds (2/3) of the registration fee.
5. The officers of the MHF shall be entitled to 50% of the registration fee.
6. A fee of RM3.00 per participant or a minimum of RM1,000.00 is paid to the MHF prior to or on the date of the state run.

7. The event shall include:
 - Runs – short/old farts & long.
 - Ball breaker Open and Closed event (Optional)– Competitive with prizes & medallions to be given. Due to additional expenses incurred to organise the ball-breaker, an additional charge of RM120.00 - RM150.00 can be charged for hashers & RM200.00 for non-hashers.
 - Dinner & Duty Paid Beverages.
 - Entertainment with emphasis on traditional hash style songs/acts,etc.
8. The details of the Bid are to be furnished and sanctioned by the MHF prior to informing the hashers eg. date, venue, registration fees, programme, goodies, accomodation, transport arrangements, etc.
9. Information of any other related activities i.e. Charity Run/Walk, Pre/Post-Amble Runs, etc.
10. The dissemination on the pertinent details of the event should be via a website, whatsapp, facebook or email.
11. Promotional items eg. t.shirt, backdrop, banners, buntings, magazines etc, are to bear the MHF logo.
12. The MHF shall provide assistance to the Host wherever possible via the MHF website, State Whatsapp Group Chat, MHF Newsletter & social media to promote a successful event.

Please be informed that the Notice of the Biennial General Meeting (BGM) scheduled on 14th June 2026 has been sent to all Affiliates and published in our website on 11th May 2026.

A. Proposed Constitutional Amendments and Establishment of State Executive Councils

We wish to inform you that MHF is proposing the following constitutional amendments to:

- i. Streamline and enhance several provisions of the Constitution; and
- ii. Establish State Executive Councils in states which do not have State Councils in order to strengthen governance, coordination, and representation at the state level, while fully preserving the democratic rights and autonomy of all affiliated chapters.
- iii. These amendments do not affect the Malacca and Johore State Councils as they remain unchanged and their respective Chairman will automatically be represented in the National Executive Council.

B. Key Benefits of Establishment of State Executive Councils

1. Scalability and Flexibility

Affiliated chapters of each state shall biennially elect the following office bearers:

- Chairman;
- Vice-Chairman;
- Hon. Secretary;
- Treasurer; and
- 3 committee members.

States with larger number of chapters may appoint three (3) additional non-voting committee members to effectively manage increased administrative responsibilities.

2. Improved Coordination

State Hash Councils will provide a structured platform to facilitate coordination of activities, events, and communication among chapters within each state.

4. Stronger National Representation

The inclusion of the State Chairmen in the National EXCO will ensure that state-level perspectives are formally represented in national discussions and decision-making.

5. Preservation of Chapter Autonomy

The safeguards and rights of individual chapters will be maintained. Voting rights at the National BGM remain exclusively with individual chapters as before.

6. Clear Separation of Roles

The proposed structure establishes clear and distinct responsibilities:

State Councils – co-ordination and development at the state level;
Hash Chapters – democratic participation and voting rights as before; and
National EXCO – strategic governance and policy direction.

7. Growth and Development

Framework for continued growth and development of hashing activities nationwide.

8. Conclusion

The overall objective of the amendments seeks to establish a balanced and progressive governance framework that:

- enhances coordination and representation at grassroots level;
- strengthens communication between chapters and the national body;
- improves national representation;
- preserves democratic participation and voting rights; and
- supports the long-term growth and sustainability of hashing activities throughout Malaysia.

- f) PERFORM SUCH FUNCTIONS AS MAY BE ASSIGNED BY THE EXCO CONSISTENT WITH THIS CONSTITUTION.

14A.4 REPRESENTATION AT NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE (EXCO)
